It examines the main EU institutions and the basic legal aspects of European integration. Moreover, this course provides insights Opis kolegija regarding the policy-making process at the EU level, as well as it offers an overview of the main theories and concepts applied in the analysis of European integration. Correspondingly, the course enables students to develop critical understanding of the major current issues concerning the European Union. 1. Understand major historical, political, legal and socio-economic features of European integration process and development of the European Union; 2. Regular class attendance - at least 70% of class attendance; 2. Fulfilled obligations of seminar presentation potpisa i polaganje and teamwork; 3. Achieving a minimum of 35% of grade during classes within assigned course activities završnog ispita cumulatively achieved by seminar presentation, teamwork and midterm exam. Continuous evaluation of student's work leads to the total grade assessment based on 100 points: sufficient (2) 50-64 points; good (3) 65-79 points; very good (4) 80-89 points; excellent (5) 90 and above points. How to earn points: Način polaganja ispita a) Course activities - 70% of the grade: 1) seminar presentation - max. 20 points. 2) teamwork - max. 20 points. 3) midterm exam - max. 30 points. b) Final exam - 30% of the grade: 4) Final exam - max. 30 points (written exam - min. 50% of correct answers is needed to pass the final exam,

i.e. it is required to earn at least 15 out of max. 30 points).

Continuous evaluation of student's work through:

- 1) Course activities: seminar presentation, teamwork and midterm exam;
- 2) Final written exam (min. 50% of correct answers is needed to pass the final exam).
