Opis kolegija	Understanding the relationship between the nation and nationalism and establishing the patterns of formation of nation-states in Europe, with a special emphasis on the Croatian nation and state. The emergence and shaping of national communities/identity construction. What is the role of cultural identification in this process, and what is the role of "blood kinship"? How do ethnic and national communities relate to political entities? To what extent is the value of the nation expressed today in the creation of a contemporary identity?
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- explain the processes of certain historical periods and topics in accordance with historiographic approaches and research achievements
- elaborate the hierarchy of historical factors and clarify the causality of historical processes
- apply the necessary knowledge from auxiliary historical sciences
- analyse the basic scientific achievements of other disciplines
- collect and classify professional and scientific literature and research sources in archives, libraries, museums and other institutions
- analyse and interpret sources, scientific and professional literature
- critically evaluate the contribution of other scientific disciplines in historiographic work
- write a paper with the characteristics of scientific work (master thesis)
- apply acquired skills for independent work and other forms of professional training in the context of lifelong learning
- adhere to ethical principles in the work and assessment of social circumstances and historical knowledge
- adopt socially responsible behaviour
