III. DETALJNI PODACI O KOLEGIJU

Jezik na kojem se nastava održava: English

Opis kolegija	<p>The course aims to introduce students to the most important political and cultural events of Croatian History from the Middle Ages to the end of the 20th century. Those key political, cultural, and social aspects of each period will be highlighted and explained within broader European context. Among other topics, the course will deal with the Croatian Kingdom in the Middle Ages and the dynastical changes; the wars against the Ottomans, the cultural achievements of Humanism and Renaissance and the period of the Enlightenment; the formation of modern national identity in the 19th century; the “Croatian question” in multinational states Croatia was part of (Austria-Hungary, Kingdom of Yugoslavia and Socialist Federative Republic of Yugoslavia); and the Homeland War and the creation of contemporary Republic of Croatia.</p> <p>After taking the course the students will be able to identify crucial events of Croatian history from the Middle Ages to the present day, identify the most important personalities and will be able to state causal relations of these complex diachronic processes.</p>
